**Services
Restrictions to Minors**

- a) The Lester Public Library is guided by the American Library Association's "Library Bill of Rights" which states that: "A person's right to use a library should not be denied or abridged because of origin, age, background or views." This all services and materials that are made available by the library to adults are equally available to minor children.
- b) The Library recognizes that parents and legal guardians have the right and the responsibility to oversee and possibly restrict their children's, and only their children's access to library resources.
- c) The library staff, upon receipt of a written request from a parent or legal guardian, will restrict the use of certain library materials or services to the minor child of that parent if it is reasonable within the ability of the staff to do so.
